Boutique hotel Bannisters Pavilion at Mollymook Beach on the New South Wales' South Coast is tapping into the food tourism phenomenon with its new Experience Series. The two-day gourmet getaways will give guests the opportunity to meet food identities and learn about food production from paddock to plate.

First up is Paul West of the River Cottage Australia television series, who will take guests to a fifth-generation oyster farmer, and meet with indigenous elder Noel Butler to learn about native bush foods.

Seafood king Rick Stein will follow in December and then Master of Cheese Will Studd will join quality purveyor Simon Johnson for a series of masterclasses next March.

The two-night package starts at \$990 a person, including accommodation at the 33-suite hotel and food experiences.
